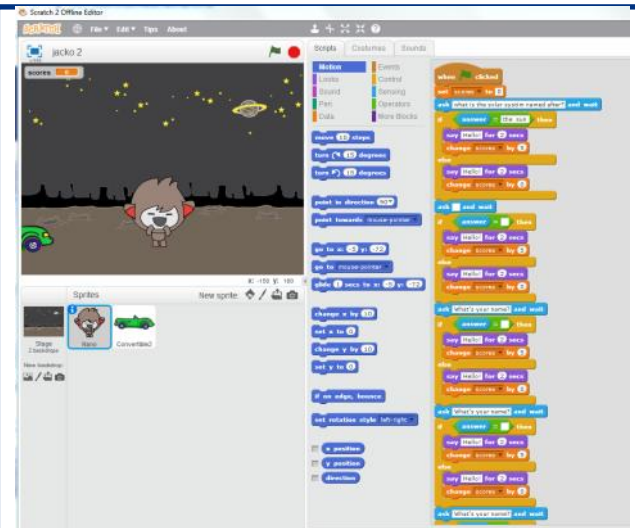
WOW!!
