Welcome to our new reps from Year 2 who have joined School Council. We have already started our latest project - developing the KS2 playground. Watch this space!



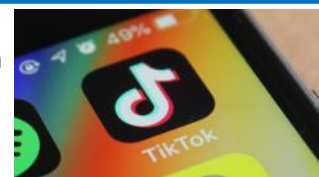
Free cycle training
