This is the result of a rigorous evaluation process and we are one of only 10 schools in the country to receive this recognition last July. It is great to see the surrounding area being used extensively with EYFS visits to Epping Forest and Y1 exploring the local area on a weekly basis during the summer term.

There is an emphasis on developing life skills, problem solving, creativity and imagination through the whole school challenge to settle on an alien planet. The children have been engaged in purposeful dialogue with local council and the Mayor of London learning valuable real life lessons through the use of a film company to highlight local pollution issues.

The subject leader, and in turn the school, is delivering high quality geographical learning

The pupils, via the school council, are integral to implementing change to the local environment such as bins and outdoor gym and building on fieldwork all of which will have long term impact on behaviour and send the message that you can make a difference.
