RECYCLING

London Fields has signed up to three new TerraCycle schemes. TerraCycle is a company which collects and recycles all sorts of previously 'unrecyclable' waste. It partners with manufacturers such as Bic and Walkers to bypass the limitations of local council recycling.



Currently, we have a battery recycling box and a pen recycling box in school.

We are now adding to our collection! After the Easter holidays there will be three new recycling boxes in the foyer. In them, we will be able to recycle:

Crisp packets! Empty, and not folded into triangles. We will post these off to TeraCycle once the bin is full.

Biscuit wrappers (made from soft plastic). Beauty product packaging that cannot go in the main recycling. This includes roll-on deodorants, baby wipe and face wipe packets.
