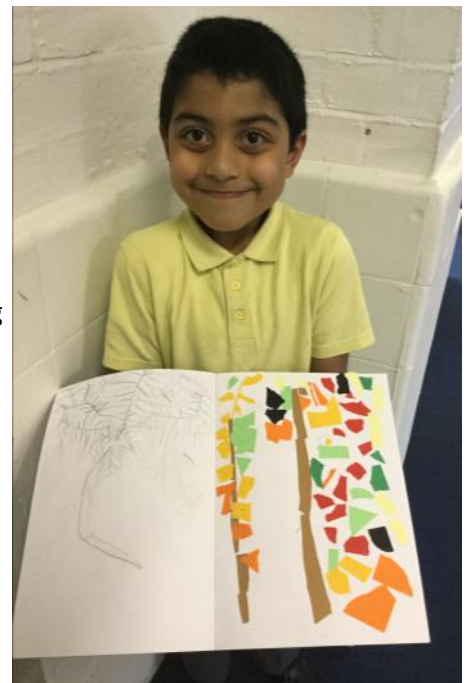


Be Bright, Stay in Sight!
